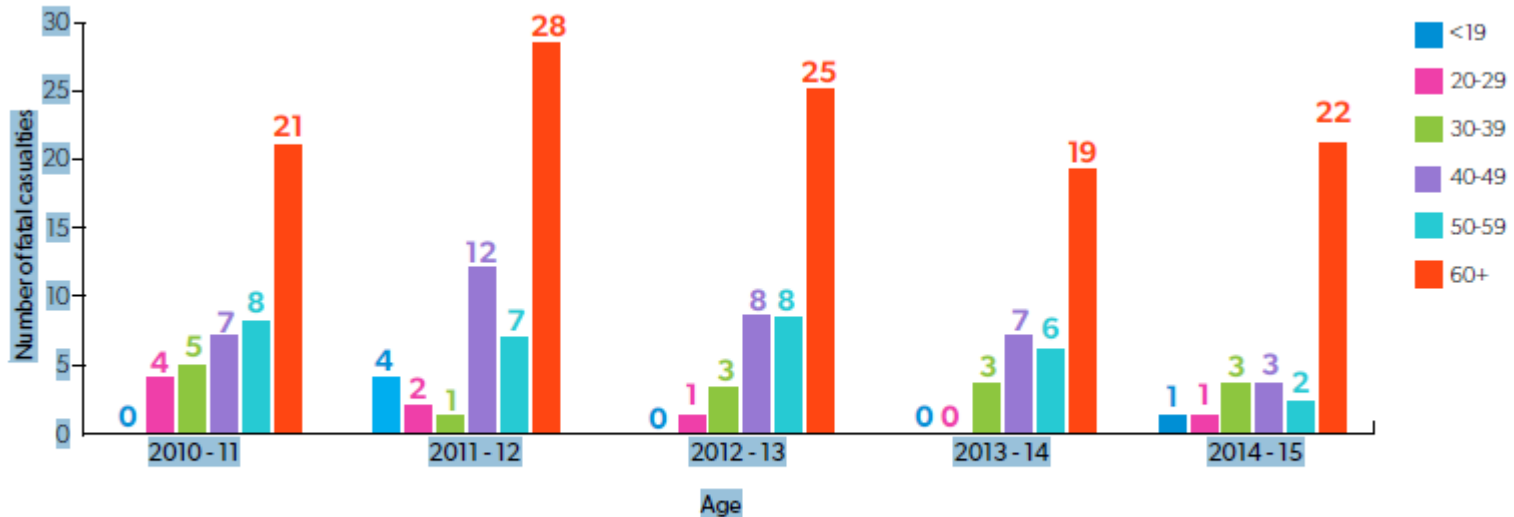


Chart 1: Fatal casualties from domestic dwelling fires by age 2010-11 to 2014-15.  
SFRS IRS Statistics, Scotland 2014-15



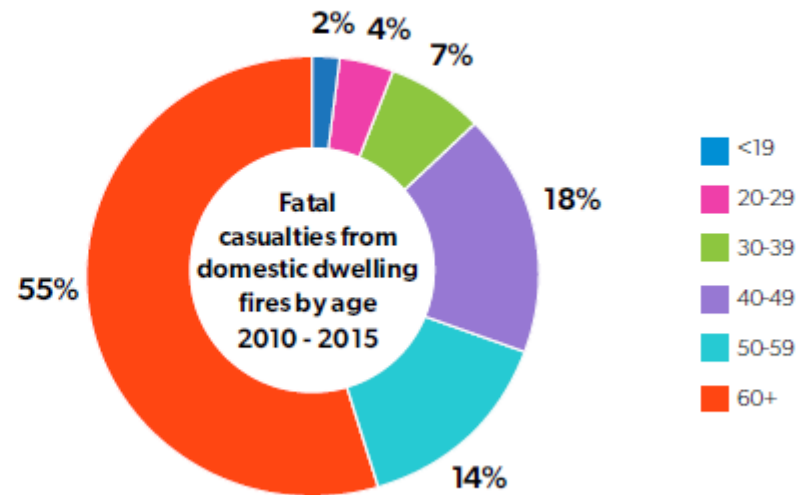
