

GLOSSARY:

PWLE Group: People with lived experience and the representatives of people with lived experience

Expert Groups: we are keen to give organisations the opportunity to work with people who use services and local citizens – please contact funding@evoc.org.uk

Locality Advisory Team: is the group of representatives who will be available to inform the process and, in the event that there is no consensus, will take locally focussed decisions at Stage 2.

Thematic Advisory Team: is the group of representatives who will be able to inform the process for thematic and citywide proposals and who will ensure that the needs of those from equalities groups, those who are multiply deprived and priority groups are being appropriately supported by accessible projects.

Citywide Advisory Team: is the group of representatives who will be available to inform the process and, in the event that there is no consensus and that the Locality Advisory Team is unable to reach agreement, will conduct the stage three allocations (see below).

Stage One: is the stage of the process which seeks to achieve a consensus among organisations within the locality and/or citywide and/or thematic.

Stage Two: is the stage of the process after attempts to seek consensus have been exhausted: in this event the Locality Advisory Team will be impanelled to endeavour to make decisions locally.

Stage Three: is the stage of the process which offers a safety net to ensure that the investment is not returned to SG. This will require the Citywide Advisory Team to be impanelled to make final decisions to oversee and ratify the output from stages 1 and 2 and direct investment into any remaining geographic or capacity gaps. The citywide panel may act as an arbiter in stage one or two where that was useful.

Locality Cooperative: is the final arrangement of all organisations within the locality following the process: including advisory, funded and service user groups. This cooperative will work during 2021/22 to develop a mechanism of formal governance to administrate any 2022/23 investment. (e.g. North West Cooperative)

Thematic Cooperative: I don't think this is needed.

Citywide Cooperative: is the final arrangement of all citywide, equalities and SOMETHING organisations who will contribute to citywide outcomes and will be primarily focussed on the delivery of outcome related to health and social inequalities, human rights.

Local Partnership: is the term used in SG guidance for the Edinburgh Third Sector Interface and Edinburgh Health and Social Care Partnership, who are responsible for the production and agreement of the Partnership Plan.

Partnership Plan: is a document which is agreed by the Local Partnership, and which governs the delivery of the Mental Health and Wellbeing Fund within Edinburgh.

Local Network: is a group of organisations which operates as a group. This might be a pre-existing group or a group which is formed to produce a collaborative expression of interest either across a geography or theme.
