

ACCESS TO INDUSTRY

EnCompass - for 22yrs & over; a service for clients with a homelessness issue, in recovery, or who have been in HMP last 3 months or have criminal justice social worker.

EdinMe - for 16-21 years; a service for young people who have an issue with or are at risk of: substance misuse, criminal justice, homelessness, or have mental health issues.

Access Progress & Access Data - services for clients with parental responsibilities, who live in Edinburgh and are either on a low income or unemployed. (Access Data is focused on helping those who would like to improve their digital and data skills and get a job in either digital or data sectors.)

Access to Industry has a Community College in 156 Cowgate (some classes are currently only delivered online, via Zoom). Our classes are open for all our service users. They are delivered by Edinburgh College tutors. This semester we're running Creative Writing, IT, Mental Health Award, Mentoring qualification, Mindfulness, Digital Media, and more.

Caseworkers are in regular contact with clients, having regular zoom meetings & also some face-to-face appointments in our office. Caseworkers will assist clients when completing application forms for college, training, or jobs; they will help to create CVs & Supporting Statements, help with interview preparation - and more.
